NACE Coating Inspectors – Levels 1, 2 & 3

JOB DESCRIPTION: The Coating Inspector is responsible for the completion of all activities in their area of assignment in accordance with the appropriate Company specifications and the approved construction drawings. The inspector receives frequent instruction and direction from their superior and the work of the inspector is checked on a frequent basis by the Chief Inspector or delegate. The inspector is not to inspect work he is not qualified to inspect.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Understanding, monitoring, assessing, and reporting on painting and coating activities and items including but not limited to:

- Vendor Product data sheet (PDS) utilization with ability to understand and interpret the PDS
- Ensure proper storage of the Paints/Coatings by the Contractor
- Tools required to monitor environmental conditions and their proper use
- Surface cleanliness testing
- Proper mixing of paint and/or coating per the manufactures PDS
- Proper application of paint and/or coating
- Proper equipment for the type of coating
- Know how to check and ensure the detector is working properly, different types of detectors and their application
- Interface with job site supervisor and quality personnel
- Safely and efficiently effect the installation, maintenance, calibration and repair of Cathodic Protection equipment
- Other duties as assigned

REQUIRED EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE/CERTIFICATES AND LICENSES:

- High school diploma or GED required, AAS or BS in Engineering or Technology preferred for higher level
- The minimum qualifications include a minimum of two years of experience in the application or inspection of coating; or one year of experience in the application or inspection of coating and either NACE CIP level 1, 2 or 3 certification or SSPC PC1, BCI, C3, QCS certifications.
- NACE CP Technician experience
- Additionally the position must meet the basic qualifications of a Utility Inspector (basic inspector).
- Demonstrated experience in the application of multiple coating systems
- API 1169 Certification
- API 510/570/653, ASW CWI preferred
- OSHA 10 or 30 Training Certificate
- TWIC
- Valid driver's license
