JOB DESCRIPTION: Perform in-process and final inspections of parts and assemblies to assure visual, dimensional and electrical compliance to specifications and/or procedures.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform inspections using a variety of inspection tools and fixtures (Calipers, Micrometers, Depth Gauges, Scales, Etc.).
- Documents and reports test results.
- Visually inspects parts/assemblies for surface irregularities, forming defects, improperly assembled or damaged components.
- Controls nonconforming product (Identify and segregate).
- Supports all manufacturing operations on a daily basis to ensure compliance with industry standards and company guidelines.
- Other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:

- High School Diploma or GED is required and will be verified.
- Successful candidates should have at least 2 years of experience as a QC Inspector.
- Ability to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing when issues arise with inspected materials.
- Must be able to coordinate occasional heavy workload through department to meet production schedule. Will occasionally be required to work overtime to meet production schedules.
- Certified for solder inspection to J-STD-001 or able to pass solder certification.
- X Ray level 1 certified or able to pass certification requirements.
- Mass Spectrometer Leak Test level 1 qualified or able to pass certification requirements.
- Able to read and interpret product drawings.
- Self-starter who pays attention to detail.
- Will be required to wear flame retardant jacket/coveralls and conductive shoes.
- Ability to obtain ATF approval to deal with client's product
